ORDINANCE NO. 815-2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE, TEXAS, BY DELETING FROM CHAPTER 1 SUBSECTION 1.1410(c) AND SUBSTITUTING THEREFOR A NEW SUBSECTION 1.1410(c) PERMITTING DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN RECORDS WITHOUT APPROVAL BY THE CITY ATTORNEY; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE, TEXAS:

Section 1. The Code of Ordinances of the City of Hilshire Village, Texas (the "Code"), is hereby amended by deleting from Chapter 1 thereof Subsection 1.1410(c) and substituting therefore a new Subsection 1.1410(c) to provide as follows:

"Section 1.410. IMPLEMENTATION OF RECORDS CONTROL SCHEDULES; DESTRUCTION OF RECORDS UNDER SCHEDULE

- (c) Prior to the destruction of a record under an approved records control schedule, authorization for the destruction must be obtained from the mayor and the city administrator or city treasurer."
- <u>Section 2.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.
- Section 3. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to

be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Hilshire Village, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.
