- ☐ Set timers on interior lights. This goes a long way in deterring burglars, who often look for crimes of opportunity.
- ☐ Set your thermostat accordingly, for unnecessary energy cost, but can also help avoid unforeseen problems with you HVAC equipment.
- ☐ Take out the trash.
- ☐ Run garbage disposal until clear.
- ☐ Secure all valuables.

What are the 3 types of identity theft?

- Financial Identity Theft
- Medical Identity Theft
- Online Identity Theft

Identity theft, also known as identity fraud, is a crime in which an imposter obtains key pieces of personally identifiable information (PII), such as Social Security or driver's license numbers, to impersonate someone else.



Prevent identity theft

- Check your credit report regularly.
- Shred unsolicited credit card applications.
- Monitor your account statements for unauthorized transactions.
- Follow up with creditors if your bills are missing.
- Keep your Social Security card and number in a safe location.
- Do not respond to spam email.
