A PROCLAMATION OF THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE, TEXAS IN RECOGNITION OF ARBOR DAY

WHEREAS, collective efforts to protect and grow our urban tree canopy inspire civic pride, enhance the character and beauty of our neighborhoods, and leave a lasting gift of natural heritage for future generations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hilshire Village is dedicated to safeguarding and strengthening its urban forest, encouraging citizens to take part in Texas Arbor Day by planting trees, supporting conservation, and deepening their understanding of the vital role trees play in daily life;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor of the City of Hilshire Village, together with the City Council, do hereby proclaim Friday, November 7, 2025, as ARBOR DAY in Hilshire Village, and encourage all citizens to celebrate by joining local tree-planting efforts and other Arbor Day activities that enhance both our community and environment.
