A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION, SERIES 2024

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hilshire Village, Texas (the "*City*"), deems it advisable to issue Certificates of Obligation to fund study, design, acquisition, demolition, construction, reconstruction, installation, purchasing, equipping, renovation, rehabilitation, extension, enlarging, and improvement of (1) City sanitary sewer systems; (2) City water supply systems; (3) City flood prevention and drainage systems; (4) City streets and thoroughfares and related land and right-of-way sidewalks, streetscapes, collectors, drainage, landscape, signage, acquiring lands and rights-of-way necessary thereto or incidental therewith; and (5) certain other costs related and incidental thereto in accordance with the Notice hereinafter set forth, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found and declared to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause to be published in the manner required by law a notice of intention to issue Certificates of Obligation in substantially the form attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3. The notice set forth in "Exhibit A" to this Resolution shall be published once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the area of the City, the date of the first publication to be before the 45th day prior to the date set in said notice for the issuance of Certificates of Obligation.

SECTION 4. The Mayor, City Secretary, and other officers of the City are hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things necessary or desirable to carry out the provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF OBLIGATION

TAKE NOTICE that the City Council of the City of Hilshire Village, Texas (the "City"), shall convene at 6:30 p.m. on September 17, 2024, its regular meeting place in the City Hall, 8301 Westview Drive, Hilshire Village, Texas, and during such meeting, such City Council will consider the passage of an ordinance authorizing the issuance of certificates of obligation to be issued in one or more series in an amount not to exceed \$3,500,000 for the purpose of paying contractual obligations to fund study, design, acquisition, demolition, construction, reconstruction, installation, purchasing, equipping, renovation, rehabilitation, extension, enlarging, and improvement (1) City sanitary sewer systems; (2) City water supply systems; (3) City flood prevention and drainage systems; (4) City streets and thoroughfares and related land and right-ofway sidewalks, streetscapes, collectors, drainage, landscape, signage, acquiring lands and rightsof-way necessary thereto or incidental therewith; and (5) certain other costs related and incidental thereto. The certificates of obligation will be payable from the levy of an annual ad valorem tax, within the limits prescribed by law, upon all taxable property within the City and from a pledge of certain available net revenues derived from the operation of the City's water and sanitary sewer system. The certificates of obligation are issued, and this notice is given, under and pursuant to the provisions of Texas Local Government Code, Section 271.049, as amended. In accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 271.049, (i) the current principal amount of all of the City's outstanding debt obligations is \$[]; (ii) the current combined principal and interest required to pay all of the City's outstanding debt obligations on time and in full is []; (iii) the estimated combined principal and interest required to pay the certificates of obligation to be authorized on time and in full is \$[1]; (iv) the maximum interest rate for the certificates may not exceed the maximum legal interest rate; and (v) the maximum maturity date of the certificates to be authorized is <u>_____, 20</u>. If prior to its approval of the proposed certificates of obligation on September 17, 2024, the City Secretary receives a petition signed by at least five percent of the qualified voters of the City protesting the issuance of the certificates of obligation, the City may not authorize the issuance of the certificates of obligation unless the issuance is approved at an election ordered, held, and conducted in the manner provided for bond elections under Texas Government Code, Chapter 1251.
