**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE ADOPTING THE 2025  
HARRIS COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS the Hilshire Village City Council recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within City of Hilshire Village; and

WHEREAS the City of Hilshire Village has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has already been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM); and

WHEREAS the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in Hilshire Village from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Hilshire Village City Council demonstrates their commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF HILSHIRE VILLAGE, TEXAS,  
THAT:**

Section 1. In accordance with Texas Local Government Code, the Hilshire Village City Council adopts the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. This plan, approved by the community, may be edited or amended after submission for review, but will not require the community to re-adopt any further iterations. This only applies to this specific plan and does not absolve the community from updating the plan in 5 years.
