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- Drink water regularly, especially in the heat.
- Limit alcohol and sugary drinks.

- Use SPF 30+ or higher.
- Reapply every 2 hours or after swimming or sweating.

Wear sunglasses that block 99-100% of UVA and UVB rays

Adults over 65, young children, and people with chronic medical conditions are most vulnerable to heat illness.
