

RESOLUTION NO. 11-2025

CITY OF HINCKLEY, MINNESOTA

AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE TO THE GREATER MINNESOTA HOUSING INFRASTRUCTURE GRANT AND AFFIRMATION OF COMMITMENT OF MATCHING FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Hinckley is committed to fostering economic growth by developing new infrastructure projects that enhance community development, attract businesses, and improve quality of life for residents; and

WHEREAS, the Greater Minnesota Housing Infrastructure Grant Program is offered by Minnesota Housing to support the creation of new infrastructure aimed at stimulating economic activity, and

WHEREAS, the proposed new infrastructure project at McGowan Avenue, including installation of a sewer lift station and force main will directly contribute to economic development by providing utilities to vacant properties for future development, and

WHEREAS, the application for the Greater Minnesota Housing Infrastructure Grant Program requires a fifty percent match, up to grant maximums, and

WHEREAS, the City of Hinckley desires to apply for this grant to fund the new infrastructure project that will catalyze economic development and improve the local community,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HINCKLEY, MINNESOTA:

1. The City of Hinckley hereby authorizes the application for the Greater Minnesota Housing Infrastructure Grant Program to support the development and improvement of affordable housing through the installation of public infrastructure.
2. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to apply for the grant on behalf of the City of Hinckley.
3. The City of Hinckley commits to adhering to all grant guidelines, housing regulations, and reporting requirements should the application be successful and the grant be awarded.
4. Any financial obligations, such as matching funds or budgetary considerations related to the new infrastructure project, will be covered as part of the organizational budget, and the City of Hinckley acknowledges its responsibility to ensure that all necessary funds are available to complete the project.
