**RESOLUTION 20-016**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,  
REAFFIRMING THEIR COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE INDOOR  
RECREATION OPPORTUNITIES TO AREA RESIDENTS VIA A MULTI-  
USE COMMUNITY CENTER.

WHEREAS, Homer City Council appropriated \$35,000 in the 2020 capital budget to fund  
a hazardous material and demolition cost estimate for HERC 1 and HERC 2; and

WHEREAS, The results of the study are anticipated by spring; and

WHEREAS, Homer City Council listed a Multi-Use Community Center, Phase 1 as one of  
the top five legislative priorities in the 2021 Capital Improvement Plan adopted via Resolution  
19-061; and

WHEREAS, Homer City Council listed HERC Demolition and Community Recreation  
Center next steps as their number one large priority Council-Initiated project for 2020 adopted  
via Memorandum 20-015; and

WHEREAS, Once demolition costs are determined, next steps will be site selection and  
preliminary design for a new Multi-Use Community Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Homer, Alaska, is  
committed to moving forward with a Multi-Use Community Center concurrent with  
determining next steps for the HERC facilities.
