A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA,  
REQUESTING THAT THE PARKS, ART, RECREATION AND  
CULTURE ADVISORY COMMISSION EXPLORE A SUITABLE VENUE  
TO DISPLAY THE SISTER CITY ART COLLECTION.

WHEREAS, The City of Homer and the City of Teshio, Hokkaido, Japan have been sister  
cities since taking an Oath to Establish the Sistership on April 17, 1984; and

WHEREAS, Teshio and Homer have enjoyed a profound camaraderie, sharing of  
families, student exchanges, ideals and memorabilia for more than thirty years; and

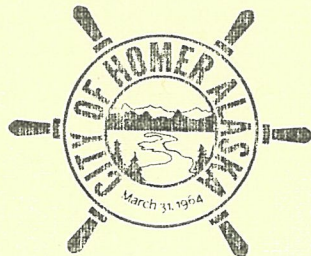
WHEREAS, Teshio has established a section within their local museum that is

Conference Room at City Hall, and not readily viewable by the general public; and


WHEREAS, The Sister City Art Collection should be in a venue that is accessible by the

the Sister City Art Collection.


