1 **CITY OF HOMER** 2 **HOMER, ALASKA** 3 City Manager 4 **RESOLUTION 18-080** 5 6 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA, 7 APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE 8 CITY OF HOMER AND THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH 9 REGARDING A REGIONAL APPLICATION TO ASSISTANCE TO 10 FIREFIGHTERS GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY 11 MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS. 12 13 WHEREAS, The purpose of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant program (AFG) is to enhance the safety of the public and 14 15 firefighters with respect to fire and fire-related hazards; and 16 17 WHEREAS, The Homer Volunteer Fire Department is in need of replacement of self-18 contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) which were purchased in 2004 and will require 19 significant upgrades to meet new NFPA Standards; and 20 21 WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the City for the SCBA to be compatible with 22 neighboring fire departments; and 23 24 WHEREAS, The regional nature of the application and collaboration between 25 departments allows for safer operations when working on multi-agency emergencies; and 26 27 WHEREAS, A regional AFG application will be more competitive than multiple 28 applications from individual departments; and 29 30 WHEREAS, As part of the Memorandum of Agreement the City of Homer is committing 31 to providing a 5% match for the SCBA at an estimated cost of less than \$10,000; and 32 33 WHEREAS, If awarded, the Homer City Council will need to appropriate the match by 34 ordinance; and 35 36 WHEREAS, The regional nature of the application and collaboration between 37 departments is to be commended. 38 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council hereby approves the 40 Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Homer and the Kenai Peninsula Borough, a 41 copy of which is attached and incorporated herein.
