Business Expansion & Kitchen Build-Out Proposal

1. Executive Summary

Copper Still Martini Lounge & Speakeasy is an established, high-performing business that has proudly contributed to the vitality of downtown Homewood for **over five years**. This proposal, which was generated after a recent meeting with **Village President Rich Hofeld and key Village staff**, outlines a strategic expansion plan to maintain our competitive edge and maximize our community contribution as we enter our **sixth year of operation**.

The plan involves installing a commercial kitchen to introduce a full-service, elevated food program. This expansion requires a total investment of \$75,000, including a prudent contingency budget, and is projected to yield an **Annualized ROI of 72.8% to 126.8%**. We respectfully request financial assistance to secure this capital investment, which promises immediate returns for the Village through job creation, increased tax revenue, and enhanced downtown activity.

2. Current Business Overview

Since opening, Copper Still built a strong reputation for hospitality and community involvement. We host regular themed events, private celebrations, and live performances that draw consistent crowds from across the region. Our focus on quality, safety, and service has resulted in five years of smooth operations without incident—an achievement that underscores our commitment to responsible business practices and community partnership.

3. Kitchen Expansion Plan

The addition of a kitchen will enable Copper Still to expand its service model, offering small plates, appetizers, and curated meals to complement its cocktail offerings. The kitchen will feature modern, efficient equipment suitable for an intimate speakeasy-style menu, allowing us to maximize space while ensuring compliance with all health and safety codes.

4. Projected Build-Out Costs

The total estimated cost for the kitchen build-out, installation, and initial stocking is **\$75,000**. This figure incorporates a crucial contingency fund to manage the financial risks associated with complex construction projects, ensuring the plan remains robust and on schedule.
