ORDINANCE NO. MC-1066

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-64 OF THE HOMEWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE INCREASING THE NUMBER OF CLASS 1 LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, Section 4-1 of the Liquor Control Act of 1934 (235 ILCS 5/4-1) authorizes a municipality to determine the number, kind, and classification of licenses for the retail sale of alcoholic liquor and local license fees to be paid for each license category; and WHEREAS, R. Scott Donkel, LLC has requested a Class 1 liquor license for their location at 2059 Ridge Road; and, WHEREAS, the Liquor Commissioner supports issuing the requested license; and WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood find it to be in the best interests of the village and its residents to increase the number of Class 1 licenses to accommodate this request. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois that SECTION ONE - AMENDMENT TO CODE: Section 4-64(c) of the Homewood Municipal Code is amended to increase the number of available Class 1 licenses by one. **SECTION TWO - EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication in accordance with law.
