## ORDINANCE NO. M-2227

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NECESSARY OR USEFUL TO THE VILLAGE OF HOMEWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4) authorizes a municipality by ordinance to sell personal property personal property no longer deemed necessary or useful to the Village in such manner as it may designate; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Homewood Fire Department recently acquired new self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) equipment using grant funds provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that purchase, the equipment listed in this ordinance is no longer needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois that:

## SECTION ONE - DECLARATION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY:

The following personal property items owned by the Village of Homewood are deemed no longer necessary or useful to this Village. The President and Board of Trustees find it to be in the Village's best interest to sell the Fire Department's retired self-contained breathing apparatus equipment which is no longer in service to the University of Illinois Fire Service Institute for \$1.00:

- 28 MSA Packs (MSA Fire Hawk 57)
- 3 RIT Packs (Rescue Air II)
- 40 Masks (Ultra Elite)

## SECTION TWO - EFFECTIVE DATE:

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in accordance with law.
