Topic: Request for Liquor License

PURPOSE

From November 2019 through January 2022, Culture Food and Entertainment Group, Inc. held a class 4A 75/25 restaurant with bar liquor license. While they were recently finishing the buildout of their kitchen, the business was closed; thus, the number of class 4A licenses was reduced. Now they are looking to re-open and are again seeking a class 4A liquor license. An increase in the allowed number of liquor licensees requires Village Board approval.

PROCESS

Culture Food and Entertainment Group, Inc. has applied for a class 4A liquor license for their location at 18031 Dixie Highway. The Liquor Commissioner supports issuing the requested license. If the Board is in approval of this request, the attached ordinance increasing the class 4A liquor licenses should be passed.

OUTCOME

Issuing a class 4A liquor license to Culture Food and Entertainment Group, Inc. will allow them to operate according to their business plan, and will enable them to offer dining options to their patrons.
