**Topic:** 2022 Rebuild IL Bond Resurfacing Program - MFT Supplemental Resolution

### PURPOSE

In the course of the 2022 Rebuild IL Bond street resurfacing project that is taking place within the Village, it has been discovered that there will be an additional cost for backfilling areas of curb replacement with concrete along Hawthorne Road. A supplemental Resolution appropriating an additional \$8,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds requires Board approval.

### PROCESS

Funding for this project currently consists of \$848,000 of Rebuild Illinois Bond funds and \$120,000 of Motor Fuel Tax funds to cover the low bid award of K-Five Construction Corporation, of Westmont, IL.

The original contract plans call for backfilling the curb replacement sections on the street side with asphalt millings, as is normally done. However, after removing the failing curb sections along Hawthorne Road, it was discovered that the gap between the new curb and the existing concrete pavement base was much wider than anticipated. Filling this larger gap with asphalt millings could potentially cause pavement settlement after resurfacing the road. Therefore, concrete will need to be utilized to fill the gap, providing a sound base upon which the asphalt resurfacing can be properly compacted.

### OUTCOME

After this supplemental resolution is approved by the Board, Public Works will instruct K-Five Construction Corporation to complete the concrete backfilling along Hawthorne Road when they have finished replacing the curb sections.

### FINANCIAL IMPACT

- **Funding Source:** MFT Funds (Rebuild Illinois Bond Funds and MFT Funds)
- **Budgeted Amount:** \$968,000
