The retirement of Sergeant Craig Sline created a vacancy for the rank of Sergeant. On Wednesday, January 8, 2025, the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners met and approved the promotion of the next officer on the current eligibility list, Detective Michael Kozlowski.

Detective Kozlowski holds a Bachelor of Science in Law Enforcement and Justice Administration from Western Illinois University and began his career with the Homewood Police Department on September 4, 2012. During his career in Homewood, Detective Kozlowski has served as a Patrol Officer, Range Officer, Tactical Officer, and since May 2019, Detective in the Criminal Investigations Unit.
