**Topic:** Donation of Surplus Property

#### **PURPOSE**

The Police Department desires to donate surplus property to Restoration Ministries, Inc., an Illinois not-for-profit corporation located in Harvey, Illinois. By law, this donation must be approved by the Village Board.

### **PROCESS**

The Homewood Police Department has found and/or recovered 22 bicycles, but has been unable to locate the owners. The bicycles have been held in storage for the statutory minimum of 180 days and are now scheduled for disposal. The Police Department seeks to donate the bicycles to Restoration Ministries instead.

Restoration Ministries, Inc. is a nonprofit organization serving south suburban communities through a variety of programs, including a thrift store, community outreach and recovery initiatives, an art center, a day camp, and after-school programs.

#### **OUTCOME**

Approval of this ordinance will authorize the Police Department to donate the bicycles in accordance with state law, and will benefit a local non-profit organization.
