

ORDINANCE NO. M-2357

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY
THE VILLAGE OF HOMEWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 authorizes a municipality to dispose of personal property no longer deemed necessary or useful to the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village owns certain items of personal property which it desires to dispose of as therein provided.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois, that:

Section One – Declaration of Surplus Property:

The following personal property owned by the Village of Homewood is no longer useful to the Village, and it is deemed in the Village's best interest that such property be disposed of.

Section Two – Method of Disposal:

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to turn over said personal property to the Village's insurance company. The property was involved in an accident on May 4, 2025, and declared a total loss. The insurance company will take ownership of the vehicle, and the Village will receive a claim payment for the totaled vehicle.

Section Three – Effective Date:

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in accordance with law.
