ORDINANCE NO. MC-1087

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 OF THE HOMEWOOD MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE- AMENDMENTS TO THE MUNICIPAL CODE:

The following subsection of Chapter 4 of the Municipal Code of the Village of Homewood is amended as follows:

Section 4-63 is hereby amended by addition of the following language, to be inserted immediately after subsection 4-63 (9):

Class 6A –Special Use Permit License. This license allows a retailer to transfer alcoholic beverages from an existing licensed retail premises to a designated site for a specific event located on property owned by a unit of local government. This license is limited to the sale of beer and wine, although sale of mixed drinks may be permitted at the discretion of the Local Liquor Commissioner. This license is valid only at the location and on the date(s) designated for the specific event on the license. An applicant for a special use permit license must submit proof of a valid local liquor license if the applicant is not licensed by the Village of Homewood, a completed Illinois Liquor Control Commission special use permit application, and proof of dram shop liability insurance. Video gaming as defined under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, ILCS Ch. 230, Act 40, §§ 1 et seq., shall not be allowed. The Local Liquor Commissioner may impose conditions deemed appropriate on any such license.

SECTION TWO-EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage, approval, and publication in accordance with law.
