Topic: Sale of Surplus Equipment

PURPOSE

Staff requests that the Village Board pass an ordinance authorizing the sale of surplus property to the City of Aurora Police Department.

PROCESS

The Homewood Police Department has acquired new light bars for their squad cars and has a surplus of light bars that will no longer be used.

The City of Aurora Police Department learned that the Village had a surplus of light bars that match the ones they currently use to upfit their police vehicles. The City of Aurora has agreed to pay \$300 each for six (6) light bars.

The surplus property to be sold is six (6) Whelen Liberty Light bars.
