AMENDMENT NUMBER 01 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

Americans with Disabilities Act Curb Ramp Project Agreement

Umatilla/Morrow County Curb Ramps Phase 2A Umatilla/Morrow County Curb Ramps Phase 2B OR 207, US 395

This is Amendment No. 01 to the Agreement between the **State of Oregon**, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "State," and "ODOT," and the **CITY OF HERMISTON**, acting by and through its elected officials, hereinafter referred to as "Agency," entered into on February 13, 2024.

It has now been determined by State and Agency that the Agreement referenced above shall be amended to update highways cited, curb ramp locations identified in Exhibit A maps and funding.

- 1. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Amendment shall become effective on the date it is fully executed and approved as required by applicable law.
- **2.** <u>Amendment to Agreement.</u> (Additions are shown in *italics* and <u>underlined</u>, deletions are shown as <u>strikethrough</u>):
 - a. The name of the Project has been changed from Umatilla/Morrow County Curb Ramps Phase 2A, Umatilla/Morrow County Curb Ramps Phase 2B, OR 207, US 730, US 395 to reflect changes in Project scope and location.
 - b. Exhibit A shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Revised Exhibit A. All references to "Exhibit A" shall hereinafter be referred to as "Revised Exhibit A."
 - c. Recitals, Paragraph 1, Page 1, is revised as follows:
 - 1. OR 207, and US 395 and US 730 are part of the state highway system under the jurisdiction and control of the Oregon Transportation Commission (OTC). OR 207 is known within the limits of this project as 11th Street and Elm Street. US 730 is known within the limits of this project as 6th Street. All city streets impacted by this project are a part of the city street system under the jurisdiction and control of Agency.
 - d. Terms of Agreement, Paragraphs 1 and 2, Page 2, are revised as follows:
 - 1. Under such authority, State and Agency agree that State shall design and construct ADA-compliant curb ramp improvements at various locations along OR 207, <u>and</u> US 395 and US 730, hereinafter referred to as "Project." The Project includes construction or rehabilitation of curb ramps, crosswalks and existing RRFB. The location of the Project is approximately as shown on the

sketch map attached hereto, marked <u>Revised</u> Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof.

- 2. The Project will be financed at an estimated cost of \$1,996,176.78 \$6,930,000.00 in federal and state funds. The estimate for the total Project cost is subject to change. State shall be responsible for any Project costs beyond the estimate.
- **3.** <u>Counterparts</u>. This Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts (by facsimile or otherwise) each of which is an original and all of which when taken together are deemed one agreement binding on all Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.
- 4. <u>Original Agreement</u>. Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement are still in full force and effect. Agency certifies that the representations, warranties, and certifications in the original Agreement are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.
- 5. <u>Electronic Signatures.</u> The Parties agree that signatures showing on PDF documents, including but not limited to PDF copies of the Agreement and amendments, submitted, or exchanged via email are "Electronic Signatures" under ORS Chapter 84 and bind the signing Party and are intended to be and can be relied upon by the Parties. State reserves the right at any time to require the submission of the hard copy originals of any documents.


