

RESOLUTION NO. 2437

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF SIX POLICE VEHICLES AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Hermiston's Police Department has developed a need to replace six police vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hermiston has planned and budgeted for the purchase of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hermiston is financing the purchase of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the loan is to pay for a capital purchase of six vehicles for the police department.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HERMISTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Hermiston Police Department (General Fund) is authorized to purchase six police vehicles.
2. That the vehicles consist of a 2026 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 and five (5) Chevrolet Traverre(s) totaling \$280,869.
3. The six vehicles financed for a term of 72 months at \$745.00 for the 2026 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 and \$782.00 per 2026 Chevrolet Traverse per month per vehicle at 6% or a total of \$4,655.00 per month.
4. The City Manager or their designee is authorized to sign the financing agreement of said vehicles.
5. That this resolution is effective immediately upon its passage.
