Title/Subject

Adoption of Resolution No. 2437 – A Resolution Authorizing Purchase of Six Police Vehicles.

Summary and Background

The police department is in need of replacing and supplanting its current fleet. This is a planned replacement and was proposed and adopted as part of the 2026-27 Budget.

The purchase consists of five (5) 2026 Chevrolet Traverses and one 2026 (1) Chevrolet Silverado 1500 pickup. These will replace three (3) of the current police vehicles which are being disposed of. The other remaining three vehicles will be shifted to other police department use and one transferred to another department.

The replacement vehicles were sourced via the State of Oregon's cooperative purchase agreement for a cost of \$44,934.00 – 2026 Chevrolet Silverado 1500 and \$47,187 – 2026 Chevrolet Traverse (per each vehicle) totaling \$280,869.

These vehicles are being financed through the Bank of Eastern Oregon for a six (6) year term at 6.0% as follows:

2026 Chevrolet Silverado 15000 – \$745.00 per month

2026 Chevrolet Traverse – \$782.00 per month (\$3,910.00 per month)

The purchase price is \$280,869 for the six vehicles to be financed over 72 months at 6.0% totaling \$782.00 (2026 Chevrolet Silverado 1500) and \$3,910.00 (2026 Chevrolet Traverse x 5) per month, respectively.
