

RESOLUTION NO. 2439

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE PFAS MITIGATION FEASIBILITY STUDY
FOR THE CITY OF HERMISTON**

WHEREAS, the City of Hermiston (“City”) operates a municipal water system and is the provider of drinking water to the citizens of the city; and

WHEREAS, PFAS has been detected in the municipal water system, and it has become necessary to create a policy and plan for removal of PFAS from the municipal water system; and

WHEREAS, the attached PFAS Mitigation Feasibility Study has been created to guide the City and provide alternatives for removal of PFAS from the municipal water system.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF HERMISTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City adopts the PFAS Mitigation Feasibility Study as the City’s policy and plan for removal of PFAS from the municipal water system.
2. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage as of the date and year set out below.
