

**Ordinance No. 1095**

**AN ORDINANCE INITIATED BY CITY OF WALSENBURG ELECTORS  
MANDATING ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT IN WALSENBURG BE PROVIDED BY  
THE HUERFANO COUNTY SHERIFF EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2017**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the city council of the city of  
Walsenburg, Colorado:

The following question shall be submitted to a vote of the registered electorate of the  
City of Walsenburg at a general election on November 8, 2016:

Without raising taxes, shall the city of Walsenburg, a Colorado statutory city, be required to  
enter into an intergovernmental agreement with Huerfano County, Colorado, which would require  
the sheriff of Huerfano County to provide any and all reasonable and necessary law enforcement  
services within the municipal boundaries of the city of Walsenburg, said intergovernmental  
agreement to include all necessary terms and conditions as agreed to by each entity, beginning  
January 1, 2017.
