WHAT IS SCSEP?

SCSEP is a community service and work-based job-training program for older Americans. Authorized by the Older Americans Act, the program provides training for low-income, unemployed people age 55 and older.

WHO IS SER?

SER was founded in 1964 and provides many services to the community in job development and training, as well as working with individuals with disabilities to help them find employment.

SER currently oversees a nationwide network of community-based organizations with 42 affiliates operating in over 200 cities.

WHAT WE DO?

We provide participants with training and support services that are important for finding future employment. The services include development of an Individual Employment Plan (IEP), specialized training, wages and fringe benefits, annual physicals and assistance in securing future employment.

- 30,093,151 hours of community service provided by SCSEP.
- 81% of partners are satisfied with SCSEP services.
- 33,562 older Americans trained
- 7945 participants obtained employment in 2017.
