# 2025 Summer Kick Off

- Kick Off event – Friday, May 31st sponsored by Texas State Teachers Association (TSTA).
- Theme- "Ice Cream Social" with ice sundae bar and small activities.
- Focus on one event to register all ages for Summer Reading program.





# Reading Logs and New Small Prizes

- ReadSquared app to log minutes.
- Paper logs will also be available.
- Program open to all ages or family units.



- Previous years- participants could win up to 4 small prizes per summer.
- New prize tiers:
  - 300 point tier and 600 point tier prizes.
  - Participant can save their points and get up to (2) "600 point" prizes.
  - Encourages to continue reading to level up prize tier.
  - We predict that participant will have more satisfaction with larger prizes.



# Summer Reading Activities

- Mix of in-person, to-go crafts, and events with TSTA.
- 14 activities between June and July.
- Pending: Partnering for 2 events with TSTA - examples: Zumba for Kids, Library @Campbell Park, or Library Mini Golf Course.
