



- Kick Off event Friday, May 31st sponsored by Texas State Teachers Association (TSTA).
- Theme- "Ice Cream Social" with ice sundae bar and small activities.
- Focus on one event to register all ages for Summer Reading program.





Reading Logs and New Small Prizes

- ReadSquared app to log minutes.
- Paper logs will also be available.
- Program open to all ages or family units.






- Previous years- participants could win up to 4 small prizes per summer.
