CITY OF HUTCHINS, TEXAS RESOLUTION 2024-09-1210

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HUTCHINS, TEXAS ESTABLISHING AN INTER-JURISDICTIONAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM WITH DALLAS COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND RECEIVING COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hutchins, by Resolution 2004-1213 and Dallas County by Commissioners Court Order Number 2004-2207 have established similar programs of comprehensive emergency management which includes the mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery phases of emergency management; and

WHEREAS, the Cities and County find that vulnerability to many potential hazards is shared by residents of Hutchins and the unincorporated portions of Dallas County; and

WHEREAS, the Cities and County further finds that the common goal of emergency management can best be achieved through an organization which shares the combined resources of the City and the County; and

WHEREAS, the contemplated action is specifically authorized by the aforementioned Resolution and Court Order.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby established the Dallas County Emergency Management program which shall consist of the officers and employees of the City and of the County as designated in an inter-jurisdictional emergency management plan, together with such organized volunteer groups as that plan may specify; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of Hutchins and the Dallas County Judge shall mutually appoint an Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate all aspects of the Emergency Management program of comprehensive emergency management, including the preparation and maintenance of an inter-jurisdictional emergency management plan for Hutchins and Dallas County in accordance with this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any party to this agreement may withdraw from the combined organization created by this resolution and its related inter-jurisdictional emergency management plan by giving sixty days advance notice in writing to each of the signatories to this resolution and to the Texas Division of Emergency Management.
