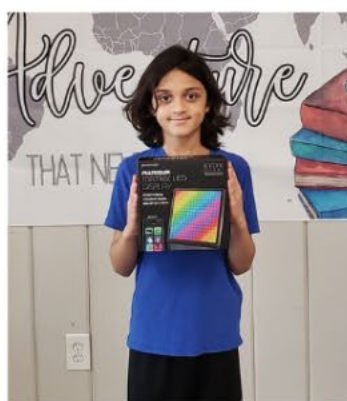
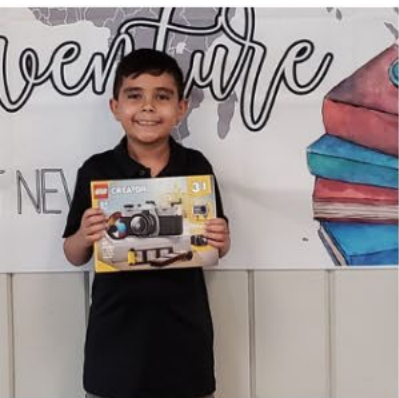

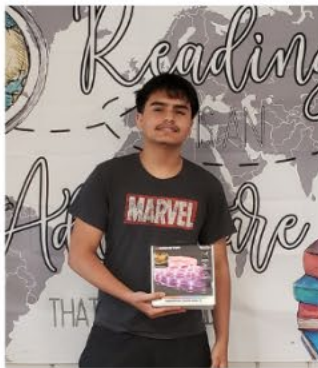

The library submitted NVRA- National Voter Registration Act Implementation Plan with SOS in June 2024.

Staff received annual training in accordance with plan.

July 2024, Dallas County Election Department made the library a HUB location. We received the multilingual voter registration stand which distributes forms addressed directly to Dallas County Election Department.
