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## **DISPLAY PROPOSAL**

**Show Date:** December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026

**Budget and Duration:** \$7,850 – for a 12-13 minute Fireworks Display  
Republic of Texas – Expandable at \$650 per additional minute

**Location:** 200 S. Denton St, Hutchins, TX 75141

**Insurance Liability Coverage:** \$1,000,000 liability policy

**Permits:** Liberty Fireworks will pull all permits necessary and will work with the Authority Having Jurisdiction to meet all state and local regulations  
The cost of the permit varies by jurisdiction and will be paid for by the client

**Personnel:** Licensed through the State of Texas

**Safety Procedures:** Liberty Fireworks adheres to all safety regulations listed in the National Fire Protection Association 1126 and the Texas Occupations Code Chapter 2154, Title 28, Chapter 34.8002

**Terms:** 50% balance due at the signing of the contract. Remainder balance due five days prior to the day of the Fireworks Display.

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## **Proposed Show Segments**

**Opening:** A barrage is designed to attract the attention of the audience and entice them to pay attention... “The show has just begun!” The opening barrage for the display will certainly impress as multiple shots of comet tails and aerial effects will fill the night’s air. As the opening barrage grows, the intensity of colors and sound will permeate the skies. **30-45 seconds**

**Feature Presentation:** The main body of the fireworks display should not be just one shot fired after another. It’s about rhythm, timing, and spacing the perfect effects with one another and building themes throughout the show. Some fireworks are designed to have extreme intensity while others are designed to slow the pace down with slower, softer effects. Every product is handpicked and designed to ensure there are nearly no duplicates of tableaux throughout the program. The audience will enjoy a fully designed display. The intensity will continue to grow until... **11-12 minutes**

**Grand Finale:** Human nature is to remember things last experienced. The Grand Finale is what people will remember the most about a fireworks production. Liberty Fireworks designs the grand finale so that the audience will not forget their experience at your venue. There will be two stages to the grand finale. The first stage will appear to be the finale with the night skies being pounded with loud explosive colors and then a short pause... The crowd will think that the show is over until we hit the quiet night skies again with loud explosions, a full array of affects and vibrant colors that will leave a lasting impression on your guests. **30-45 seconds**

1 x 24 Shot Mortar Rack

*Approximately 100 shots and effects*

### **Body**

Multiple angled and straight mortar racks (60g canister shells)

Combination of 200g multi-effect cakes

Combination of 500g fan and multi-effect cakes

Combination of 1000g fan and multi-effect cakes

*Approximately 1,100 shots and effects*

### **Grand Finale**

Multiple angled and straight mortar racks (60g canister shells)

Combination of 200g multi-effect cakes

Combination of 500g fan and multi-effect cakes

Combination of 1000g fan and multi-effect cakes

Multiple zipper cake with various effects

1 x Fan slice / sweep for grand finale

*Approximately 450 shots and effects*
