Background Information

On March 16, 2026, the City Council approved a traffic impact study to evaluate two concerns along Trout Road: (1) vehicles traveling above the posted speed limit, and (2) whether the intersection of Trout Road and Dowdy Ferry Road warrants additional traffic control measures.

Engineering firm Kimley-Horn conducted the study addressing both issues and subsequently issued the following recommendations.
