## **Background Information**

On August 29<sup>th</sup> staff met with the city manager and deputy manager for the City of Glenn Heights to discuss a future joint animal shelter project. Glenn Heights has expressed their interest in a shared animal shelter between the Cities of Hutchins and Glenn Heights.

Consideration to be given to the following locations:

Existing Hutchins City Hall, located at 321 N. Main St. in the City of Hutchins.

Former Police and Public Works facility located at 550 W. Bear Creek, in the City of Glenn Heights.

New construction, location TBD.
