## **Background Information**

The Water Supply and Infrastructure Grants (WSIG) program is a one-time statewide funding opportunity administered by the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) to support critical water infrastructure needs across Texas. It is designed to fund planning, design, and construction projects that enhance water availability and improve water system reliability. The program provides 100% grant funding with no local match required, making it especially valuable for small and mid-sized communities. Resolution XXX supports a request for funding from the Texas Water Development Boards Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant for Water Conservation and Improvements to pipelines and water infrastructure across the city. Total funding request not to exceed \$10,000,000.
