

**RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE CITY COUNCIL
IN SUPPORT OF APPLICATION FOR THE RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM
FOR THE CLEAR CREEK GREENWAY TRAILHEAD KIOSK AND WASTE
RECEPTACLES**

WHEREAS, the Recreational Trails Program is a grant funding program administered by the Federal Highway Administration through the North Carolina State Division of Parks & Recreation.

WHEREAS, the City of Hendersonville is committed to providing its citizens and visitors with safe, accessible, and valuable trails and recreational infrastructure with the goal of providing the highest quality of life for its citizens.

WHEREAS, the City of Hendersonville wishes to pursue funding opportunities that would allow the City to improve the accessibility of current infrastructure and increase the quality of infrastructure and our city assets for public enjoyment.

WHEREAS, the City's financial resources have limited the City's ability to fund recreational project upgrades meant to enhance the users experience.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hendersonville, North Carolina that:

1. The City hereby endorses the application for the Recreational Trails Program and, if awarded, provide the 20% required match of funds for the project, as well as staff assistance for the duration of the project; and
2. The City Manager is authorized to execute said application.
