

RESOULTION BY THE CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING A GRANT FROM THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE CERTIFIED LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the State Historic Preservation Office, utilizing pass through funds from the National Preservation Fund, has established a grant program for qualified Certified Local Governments (CLGs) in North Carolina to be used for restoration work on historic buildings within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission applied for and was awarded \$25,000 for work on the Round House in Oakdale Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hendersonville desires to accept the grant funds, and authorize the execution of the grant funding agreement (the “Grant Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Grant Agreement provides that the City will undertake activities to promote the historic preservation of Oakdale Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the City is not required to provide matching funds for this grant; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City council of the city of Hendersonville, North Carolina that:

1. The City hereby accepts the \$25,000 Certified Local Government grant from the State Historic Preservation Office for the purposes as set out in the Grant Agreement; and
2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Grant Agreement, with such changes as he deems appropriate, provided they are consistent with the terms of this Resolution;
3. City Staff are authorized and directed to proceed with the performance and implementation of the Certified Local Government grant as outlined in the Grant Agreement.
