SUGGESTED MOTION(S):

I move that City Council adopt the Resolution to Authorize The City Manager to Execute an Agreement to Enter Into A Ten-Year Agreement With The North Carolina Department Of Transportation For Bridge Inspection Services Contract.

SUMMARY:

The City is required by the National Bridge Inspection Standards to inspect all structures defined as bridges located on public roads on a cycle, not to exceed twenty-four months. The City would like to enter into a ten-year agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the Department or a Consultant retained by the Department to inspect and analyze all public bridges located on our Municipal Street System that qualify for the program. The City currently has nine bridges that qualify. Under this program, the City is responsible for 20% and NCDOT is responsible for 80% of the inspection costs. The approximate cost to the City for a bridge inspection is \$650 per structure. The City also has four bridges that do not qualify for this program because they are below the minimum size. The City is responsible for 100% of the inspection costs for these structures. The approximate costs for a bridge inspection is outside of the program is \$3,200. The City will contract with NCDOT's consultant or a different consultant to inspect the four smaller bridges.
