- 1. The City of Hendersonville does designate the Community Development Director as the City's Zoning Administrator with all associated rights and responsibilities conveyed to whomever occupies that position within the organization.
- 2. Furthermore, the City of Hendersonville does designate the Community Development Director and Zoning Enforcement Officer(s) as the City's Code Enforcement Officer(s) with all associated rights and responsibilities conveyed to whomever occupies those positions within the organization.
