## "Fix A Leak" Week 2022

**WHEREAS**, household water leaks account for nearly 1 trillion gallons of water wasted across the United States each year, equal to the annual household water use of nearly 11 million homes; and

**WHEREAS**, finding and fixing leaks is as easy as 1, 2, 3! Check, twist, and replace by checking toilets for silent leaks, twisting to tighten fixture connections, and replacingbroken fixtures with WaterSense<sup>®</sup> labeled models; and

**WHEREAS**, many common household leaks, including worn toilet flappers, leaking showerheads, and dripping faucets are easily corrected; and

**WHEREAS**, fixing leaks can save homeowners an average of 10,000 gallons of waterper year, or the amount of water in a typical backyard swimming pool; and

**WHEREAS**, WaterSense<sup>®</sup> is a voluntary partnership program sponsored by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to protect the future of our nation's water supply by promoting water efficiency and WaterSense<sup>®</sup> labeled products; and

**WHEREAS**, the EPA's WaterSense<sup>®</sup> program celebrates Fix a Leak Week the third week of March as a time to remind Americans to check their household fixtures and irrigation systems for leaks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hendersonville Water and Sewer Department is partnering with WaterSense<sup>®</sup> to encourage citizens to find and fix leaks and promote efficient water use to ensure sufficient watersupply for future generations.
