## **SUMMARY:**

The Lower Mud Creek Floodplain Restoration Project has received funding from the NC Land & Water Fund and NC Division of Water Infrastructure in the amount of \$3.2 million dollars to complete design, permitting, and restoration of 26 acres of vacant land owned by the City of Hendersonville. However, these grants will not fund passive recreational amenities such as trails. The City wishes to create passive recreational opportunities as part of this project and conceptual designs have already been completed for these features. The NC Division of Water Resources Water Resource Development Grant Program provides funding for recreation amenities such as those proposed for this project. Therefore, the cost of these amenities are eligible to be funded through the NCDWR Water Resource Development Grant. Based on preliminary cost estimates developed by the project engineer, stormwater staff are requesting \$200,000 from the State of North Carolina to construct these recreational amenities as part of the Lower Mud Creek Floodplain Restoration Project.
