

**RESOLUTION BY THE HENDERSONVILLE CITY COUNCIL TO AUTHORIZE THE DONATION OF TWO POLICE CRUISERS TO BLUE RIDGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

**WHEREAS**, the Hendersonville Police Department owns two surplus police cruisers, being: (1) a 2019 FORD EXPLORER, VIN: 1FM5K8ARXKGA28695, COH Vehicle ID: 14-184, and (2) a 2018 FORD EXPLORER, VIN: 1FM5K8AR4JGA26648, COH Vehicle ID: 14-185; and

**WHEREAS**, the police cruisers are no longer in use by the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Blue Ridge Community College (“BRCC”) desires to acquire the police cruisers for use in their Law Enforcement Training programs; and

**WHEREAS**, N.C.G.S § 160A-274 authorizes the City to exchange with, lease to, lease from, sell to, or purchase from any other governmental unit, including BRCC any interest in real or personal property upon such terms and conditions as the governmental unit deems wise, with or without consideration; and;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hendersonville has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to convey police cruisers to BRCC, and deems it wise to do so for no consideration.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Hendersonville, North Carolina that:

1. The following Police Cruisers are deemed surplus and approved to be sold:
  - a. 2019 FORD EXPLORER, VIN: 1FM5K8ARXKGA28695, COH Vehicle ID: 14-184
  - b. 2018 FORD EXPLORER, VIN: 1FM5K8AR4JGA26648, COH Vehicle ID: 14-185
2. The City Council Councils authorizes the conveyance Police Cruisers described hereinabove to the State Board of Community Colleges C/O Blue Ridge Community College, for no consideration, in accordance with §160A-274.
3. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Bill of Sale with the State Board of Community Colleges C/O Blue Ridge Community College.
