RESOLUTION BY THE CITY OF HENDERSONVILLE CITY COUNCIL IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION BY CITY OF BREVARD FOR USDOT RAISE GRANT FUNDING TO CONSTRUCT THE ECUSTA TRAIL IN TRANSYLVANIA COUNTY
