### **SUGGESTED MOTION(S):**

I move City Council to adopt *An Ordinance of the City of Hendersonville City Council to Amend Certain Provisions of the Code of Ordinances Related to Criminal Enforcement* as presented for its second reading.

**SUMMARY:** In 2021, the NC Legislature adopted SL 2021-138, otherwise known as Senate Bill 300, to decriminalize City Ordinances as a whole. The Legal department has prepared the attached ordinance to comply with the new requirements imposed by SB 300.

At its February meeting, City Council voted to adopt the attached ordinance for its first reading. NCGS § 160A-175, as amended by SB300, requires two readings for any ordinance specifying a criminal penalty.
