2. **NEW BUSINESS**

- Joe Volpe has joined the committee.
- A. Rhythm & Brews 2023
 - > Musicians
 - Head liners are nailed down for the MOST part not signed yet
 - With the help of a TDA grant we are able to have bigger groups perform at R&B (increase \$10,000 entertainment budget)
 - > Sponsorships and Vendors
 - Updating the sponsor packet getting that out
 - Waiting to hear back from returning sponsors
 - o Kids zone sponsor someone is interested
 - > Event Layout
 - Will potentially be able to use the lot this year (2023) for our super fan tent
 - Jamie has been in contact with Chris Rivera (JC Parking) who has taken over management of the parking for that lot.
 - We would not want to do a layout switch mid-year, suggestion is to come up with a couple of options just in case
 - Adding the sponsor tent as an extension to the beer garden, moving the beer garden up closer to Barnwell, or moving the stage back around 20 feet towards Caswell.
 - Roped off seating in front of the sponsor tent towards the stage for VIP
 - Would want to have good separation between the beer garden and sponsor tent
 - Spray-paint a layout before the first show to make sure that it's all mapped out correctly.
 - Sierra Nevada might be bringing in tap trucks
 - Note There might be a need for a more secure way to have the backstage as we get bigger bands to come to R&B
 - Make people walk around backstage from Caswell make it harder to get backstage (provide a more private tent?) maybe have the tent for the band's personal belongings

- o Bands will probably want/expect more security
- Do a trial run this year with VIP tent on street.

B. Hendersonville Farmers Market 2023

- Sponsor packet updated 7 already nailed down waiting to hear back from 2 more
- Applications are going to be going out to returning vendors
- Vendor Advisory Committee has new members rotating in
- Keeping the market, the same as possible this year due to the street scape that will be happening

3. OTHER BUSINESS

A. Garden Jubilee

- We have a contract with Dragonfly Marketing to manage vendors for the event.
- February 5th is the deadline for previous venders
- Then after that we will open up to new vendors with a march 25th deadline
- New logo, working together with TDA on marketing.

B. Holiday Events

- Overall, the Holiday events were a hit
- Keep ideas open for future Santa arrivals
- Getting more carriages for the Holiday events to try and get as many people as possible
- Tree Lighting
 - o Huge attendance
 - o Focus on Santa
 - o Focus and music- do better on the sound for the future music groups
 - High school performances
 - Move the Horse and Carriages away from the Tree Lighting
 - o Adding additional vendors and smaller activities

C. Bearfootin'

 - o First time the Friends stepped in Great success
 - o Continue adding more singing and music groups
 - Continue the Carriage Rides at this event
