

PLANNING BOARD RECOMMENDATION

PETITION REQUEST: 7th Ave – Chariff (CMU to CMU)

APPLICANT/PETITIONER: Lyle Chariff, 407 NC Holdings, LLC (Owner/Applicant)

PLANNING BOARD ACTION SUMMARY:

Staff gave a 10-minute presentation on the requested development - reviewing the petition in light of guidance from the Gen H Comprehensive Plan and the criteria for considering a rezoning. The Planning Board asked questions pertaining the impact of the National Register Historic District. In total Planning Board considered this item for 20 minutes.

APPLICANT PRESENTATION:

The applicant was present and spoke briefly on behalf of the petition and expressed his support for historically sensitive development in the 7th Ave area.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

- Lynne Williams, Chadwick Ave – expressed concerns in regards to gentrification and displacement in the 7^{th} Ave area.

DELIBERATION:

- The Planning Board deliberated about the importance of opportunities for the appropriate redevelopment in 7th Ave as afforded by the CMU zoning. Staff also offered clarification on the difference between a local historic district (regulated) and a National Register Historic District (not regulated)

MOTION:

- Chauncey Whiting moved that the Planning Board recommend approval providing the following:

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN CONSISTENCY STATEMENT:

The proposed zoning of Central Mixed Use (CMU) aligns with the Gen H 2045 Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use & Conservation Map and the Character Area Description for 'Downtown'

REASONABLENESS STATEMENT:

[Rationale for Approval]

- 1. CMU zoning would be extended to align with adjacent zoning.
- 2. The permitted uses and development standards of the CMU zoning aligns with the existing character of the subject properties.
- 3. CMU standards will allow for new infill development designed to complement the surrounding 7th Ave area in a way that C-2 zoning will not.
