SUGGESTED MOTION(S):

I move that City Council approve the Governor's Crime Commission Grant Sole Source requests and approve the associated Sole Source purchases in the amount of \$15,806.00 to Axon Enterprises for the purchase of tasers/equipment, \$4,274.20 to Kimball Communications for radios and equipment, and \$4,870.63 to IFak for equipment related to rescue essentials, pursuant to the City of Hendersonville Uniform Guidance Procurement Policy.

SUMMARY:

The Department of Public Safety Governor's Crime Commission has awarded the City of Hendersonville a \$24,480 grant for FY20-21. This Grant was Approved on March 4th, 2021, Resolution # R-21-14. Pursuant to City of Hendersonville Uniform Guidance Procurement Policy.

VI. Exceptions. Noncompetitive procurements are allowed only under the following conditions and with the written approval of the federal agency or state pass-through agency that awarded the federal funds:

A. Sole Source: when the item is available from only one source. The City department responsible for the solicitation shall document the justification for and lack of available competition for the item. A sole source Federal Contract must be approved by City Board.

Sole Source Requests to the Governor's Crime Commission have been Approved as the equipment requested are Proprietary to services and training that have already been utilized and in effect. \
