TITLE OF ITEM: Engineering Agreement Amendment for the French Broad River Intake and Pumping Station Permanent Repairs Project – *Adam Steurer, Utilities Director*

SUGGESTED MOTION(S):

I move City Council to adopt the Resolution By the City of Hendersonville to authorize the City Manager to execute an amendment to the agreement with Black & Veatch International Company for engineering services to support the construction of the French Broad River Intake and Pumping Station Permanent Repairs Project.

SUMMARY:

Prior to completion of construction, the French Broad River Intake and Pumping Station was substantially flooded from Hurricane Helene. The City originally contracted with Black & Veatch International Company for engineering design services for the French Broad River intake and pumping station on July 26, 2017. Now it is necessary to perform additional, permanent repairs to the French Broad River Intake, mostly to damaged electrical and control equipment, in order to restore it to its pre-storm condition. This work requires engineering support outlined in the attached amendment to the original engineering agreement.

BUDGET IMPACT: Costs will be reimbursed by FEMA, and/or other funding sources.
