PETITION REQUEST: Zoning Reforms for Missing Middle Housing (PRD)

APPLICANT/PETITIONER: City of Hendersonville

#### PLANNING BOARD ACTION SUMMARY:

Staff gave a <u>15-minute</u> presentation on the requested development – reviewing the details of the proposed revisions, tying the proposals to the Gen H Comprehensive Plan and the criteria for considering a rezoning. The Planning Board asked questions pertaining to walkability/pedestrian connections, permitted uses in CHMU vs UR and the targeted population for the units.

In total Planning Board considered this item for 24 minutes.

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT:**

- Ken Fitch, 1046 Patton St – stated that we may create more units but also create more incompatibility and that developers may not follow what they have proposed.

- I. The proposed amendment creates an opportunity to address the need for additional gentle density missing middle housing.
- 2. The proposed amendment establishes standards to encourage walkable neighborhoods.
- 3. The proposed amendment compliments existing provisions to incentive the construction of smaller, more affordable dwellings ("starter homes").
