SUGGESTED MOTION(S):

I move the City Council adopt An Ordinance of the City of Hendersonville City Council to Readopt and Amend Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances for the City of Hendersonville with Respect to the Welfare of Animals as presented for its first reading.

SUMMARY: ASAC and Police Department staff have spent significant time since then reviewing Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances and have proposed a reorganized Chapter relating to animals.

At the June 28, 2023 meeting, the City Council heard a presentation on the proposed Ordinance. The Ordinance is now being presented to the City Council for a first vote. Because the proposed ordinance includes criminal penalties, it will require two votes to become effective.
