SUGGESTED MOTION(S):

I move City Council to adopt the Resolution By the City of Hendersonville to authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract for the construction of the Water Treatment Facility Filter Expansion Project

SUMMARY:

The City owns and operates a water treatment facility (WTF) that has a permitted capacity of 12 million gallons per day (mgd) and intends to install additional dual media filters and associated piping, instrumentation, and appurtenances, which will increase the facility's permitted capacity to 15-mgd.

On August 20, 2024, at 2:00pm am sealed formal bids were received for the Water Treatment Facility Filter Expansion project summarized below:

Formal bids were reviewed by staff for completeness and accuracy. Cove Utility, LLC. was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the total bid amount of \$1,788,900.50.
